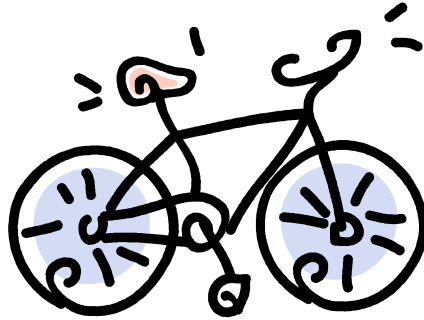


The first Troop 62 trip of the year will be to

Camp Johnson and the Airline Trail

Johnson Road, Bolton, CT and 500 Church St., Hebron, CT

Sept. 12-13



This trip will feature a bike ride on a gravel trail. Mountain and hybrid-type bikes would be preferred. The trail is a former railroad and has no steep hills. **There will be a mandatory bike check 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. Sunday Sept. 6 at Geissler's parking lot.** (If you are unable to make this check because of family Labor Day activities, see Mr. King or Mr. Stone.) Your bike will be loaded onto the trailer after this safety check. Please note that **you must wear a helmet when riding.**

An alternative activity (a hike at Camp Johnson) will be available for those who do not wish to bike.

Cost: \$20 per person, due by Sept. 10 meeting

Leaving: 7:30 a.m. Saturday Sept. 12 from Geissler's parking lot

Returning: approximately noon, Sunday Sept. 13

Cooking: Patrol cooking – Patrol leaders will be the cooks, planning and making Saturday lunch (sandwiches), Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast (both cooked).

Determine menus at patrol meetings. Shopping Friday night Sept. 11. Spending limit is \$12 per person (troop will not reimburse more than that).

What to bring: Sleeping bag and pad, pillow, rain gear, flashlight, bike helmet, a cup for drinks, day pack, water bottle, sunscreen.
