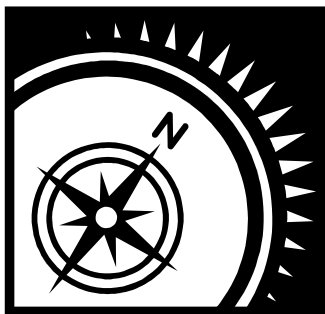


Work on your scout skills during a weekend at

Activities: firebuilding, building your own shelter, orienteering (map and compass), lashing and camp gadgets, short hike, storytelling/singing/skits.

Webelos will be camping with us. **Webelos must be accompanied by a parent.** Webelos scouts will sleep with a fellow Webelos scout buddy in a troop tent (provided). Parents will sleep nearby (troop tents also available). Contact Bob King at 648-1214 or bobking18@yahoo.com with any questions.

To bring: Bedding (sleeping bag, mat or air mattress, pillow), rain gear, water bottle, drinking cup, bug repellent, flashlight, compass (if you have one), clothing that can be layered (dress for the weather), good walking shoes, your scout handbook (if you are second class or below) and most of all, good scout spirit! The troop will provide tents; **Troop 62 scouts may bring tarps or space blankets to make their own shelters for sleeping.** Troop 62 scouts also bring under-tent plastic from previous trips.

Leaving: Troop 62 leaving 6:30 p.m. Friday Oct. 16 from Geisslers. Webelos and parents should arrive at the property at 9 a.m. Saturday Oct. 17. All returning approx. noon on Sunday (also Geisslers).

Cost: \$15 per person. (\$10 for Webelos scouts.) Money and signup is due by the Oct. 8 troop meeting. Troop 62 scouts -- no exceptions please.

Cooking will be all-troop, not patrol cooking. Troop 62 scouts: Be prepared for any cooking or clean-up assignment.
