

BSA Troop 62 Old Main St. Cleanup

We will be doing our annual community service project, cleaning the sides of Old Main Street, from North King St. to the South Windsor town line, on Thursday, April 28, 2011. We will meet at the intersection of North King Street and Old Main Street at 6 PM. Please wear old, bright clothes with long sleeves and long pants. Feel free to bring gloves, but we will supply latex gloves and safety vests.

If you have not done this activity with us before, a parent will need to sign a town-supplied consent form. This form will be available when you arrive. If you are having someone else bring your scout, Please give WRITTEN permission to any parent who brings your scout to the cleanup, so they can sign the form. If you have already participated in this cleanup, you do not have to sign the form again. New Scouts (this year) can participate, as long as they are age 10 or over (per South Windsor Town regulations).

The cleanup will take about one hour; we will have snacks and drinks (after we clean up!). After completion of the cleanup, we will proceed to St. Peter's. Scouts can be picked up at St. Peter's at 9:00 PM as usual. Drivers will be needed to assist with the cleanup and to transport Scouts to the regular troop meeting afterwards.

This is one of our major community service projects, and everyone should try to come. This will count toward your service hour requirements.
